- Minimum Course Passing Grade: 60 - <63% (GPA = 1.3)
- Maximum Grade: $\geq 90\%$ (GPA = 4.0)

Graduation requirements

- Achieving a cumulative GPA of no less than 2.00. Students who do not meet this requirement must retake one or more courses in order to raise their GPA to the minimum threshold required for graduation.
- Rectifying any failing grades (F, DN, NE, or BL) in any compulsory course by successfully passing the respective examinations.
- Completing the minimum number of credit hours required for the degree.
- Meeting the above requirements within a period not exceeding twice the original duration of the academic program as stated in the faculty's regulations.
- Completing the prescribed study period as outlined in the faculty's regulations and syllabus.
